

INVITATION FOR BIDS

Submitted bids will be opened electronically at 11:00 AM on **Friday, March 13, 2026**; and will be posted to the Vermont Agency of Transportation website. The time of receiving and opening bids may be postponed due to emergencies or unforeseen conditions.

LOCATION: BEGINNING IN THE TOWN OF WATERBURY AT MILE MARKER 63.000 AND EXTENDING NORTHERLY ALONG INTERSTATE ROUTE 89 (SOUTHBOUND) FOR A DISTANCE OF APPROXIMATELY 82,368.00 FT (15.600 MILES) TO MILE MARKER 78.600 IN THE TOWN OF RICHMOND.

TYPE OF CONSTRUCTION: WORK TO BE PERFORMED UNDER THIS PROJECT INCLUDES SURFACE PREPARATION INVOLVING PATCHING, POT HOLE REPAIR, CRACK SEALING, MILLING AND PAVING WITH A LEVELING COURSE AND A WEARING COURSE ON THE EXISTING INTERSTATE TYPICAL, PAVEMENT MARKINGS, GUARDRAIL REHABILITATION, AND OTHER RELATED HIGHWAY ITEMS.

CONTRACT COMPLETION DATE: This Contract shall be completed on or before **October 09, 2026**.

BID BOND: Electronic bid bond to be submitted in the amount of 5% of the Contractor's bid.

ENGINEER'S ESTIMATE: For this proposal the Engineer's Estimate is **Category F**.
