SPECIAL PROVISIONS

1. NOTICE TO BIDDERS – CONTRACT COMPLETION DATE. This Contract shall be completed on or before October 9, 2026.
2. NOTICE TO BIDDERS – PROHIBITION OF RUSSIAN GOODS. The Contractor is hereby notified that, pursuant to Vermont Executive Order No. 02-22, dated March 3rd, 2022, the purchase of Russian-sourced goods and goods produced by Russian entities (defined as institutions or companies that are headquartered in Russia or have their principal place of business in Russia) is prohibited. The awarded Contractor must fill out and sign the Executive Order 02-22 Vendor Certification as part of Contract awarding process.
3. NOTICE TO BIDDERS – BRIDGE 57S. The Contractor is hereby notified that any fine-milled surfaces within the area of Bridge 57S will be repaved within 14 calendar days.
4. NOTICE TO BIDDERS – TRAFFIC PHASING WORK REQUIREMENTS. The Contractor is hereby notified that no more than three miles of a single lane closure at any given time is allowed **during any daytime construction operations. For the purposes of this provision the term “daytime” is all work which occurs between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m.** A single lane closure is defined as the distance from the point where traffic is fully reduced from two lanes of travel to one lane of travel to the point where traffic is fully restored back to conditions prior to construction.
5. NOTICE TO BIDDERS – WORK HOUR RESTRICTIONS. The Contractor is hereby notified that all work between MM 63.000 and MM 65.000 including Exit 10 Ramps D, E, F, and G and all work between MM 76.000 and MM 78.600 including Exit 11 Ramps A and B shall be performed between the hours of 7:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. of the next calendar day. The Engineer may abbreviate this time period as necessary.

All work shall be completed in accordance with the requirements of Subsection 105.14(c) and Subsection 105.14(d).

6. NOTICE TO BIDDERS – ELECTRONIC DOCUMENT MANAGEMENT. The Contractor is hereby notified that the Contractor, their subcontractors, and suppliers shall create both a Doc Express and an iCXWeb account. The Contractor shall use these applications for collection and management of electronic documents.
